During this hands on creative experience, attendees will be introduced to the fundamentals of shoemaking, including cutting, sewing, and assembling shoe components. By the end of the day, participants will have crafted their own one-of-a-kind quilted shoes.

Materials:

- Exterior fat quarter
- Lining fat quarter
- Fat quarter of Fusible Fleece
- Sneakerkit outsole and insole kit.

- Crewel needle size 2
- 3/16" eyelet kit. Recommended [setter](#) and [eyelets](#).
- [Tooling or Scratching awl](#)

- Shoelaces
- Sewing machine and standard sewing notions (pins, thread, iron, pressing mat, cutting mat, scissors, rotary cutter, etc)
